ENRICHMENT WORKSHOPS:

Degree Attainment – Youth are provided with advising on identifying different career paths after high school such as academic institutions, prerequisite courses, financial aid, admissions and more.


Follow your Dreams, Build your

Future – Encourage youth to pursue promising careers that lead to professional and personal achievement. Mentors in different career paths speak to the youth about their experiences. **Resume Building** – Youth participate in a hands-on process of developing a working resume.

Career Preparation – Youth are provided with interview techniques and coaching on professional attire in preparation for job interviews.

Financial Planning – Youth are guided through developing a budget; establishing a budget, paying bills, saving, and managing paychecks, etc.






